 - -Building additions and renovations at Garfield, Harrison, Lowell, Nisswa & Riverside
- -Renew WESB for Early Childhood, Fun 'N' Friends, administrative offices
- Proposal for Secondary Schools

Introduced at Nov. 24 Board of Education meeting

- -Brainerd High School to house grades 9-12, with updated pool, activities space, and auditorium
- -Repurpose South Campus for LEC & Transitions programs
- -Brainerd Learning Center to house expanded MLAP & AEC programs
- -Improve drop-off/pick-up and safety & security at Forestview
- Approval of April 10, 2018 for Election Day
